ARP Funds and Gov. Mills' MJRP

- The Maine Jobs & Recovery Plan (MJRP) is Governor Mills' plan, approved by the Legislature, to invest nearly \$1 billion in federal American Rescue Plan funds to improve the lives of Maine people and families, help businesses, create good-paying jobs, and build an economy poised for future prosperity.
- \$20 Million towards Maine CTE's- Part of Gov. Mills' MJRP

\$20 Million split into two RFA's (Request for Applications)

- CTE Personnel Infrastructure and Equipment:
 - \$4.5 Million of which over \$4 Million was awarded to 23 applicants.
 - Awards included personnel to increase class size in large or growing programs, large equipment such as police training simulators and forwarders. Equipment and personnel to help align programs with latest technology and industry standards.
- CTE Infrastructure:
 - \$15.4 Million to be awarded to applicants for large infrastructure projects. Applications due Sept. 22nd.
