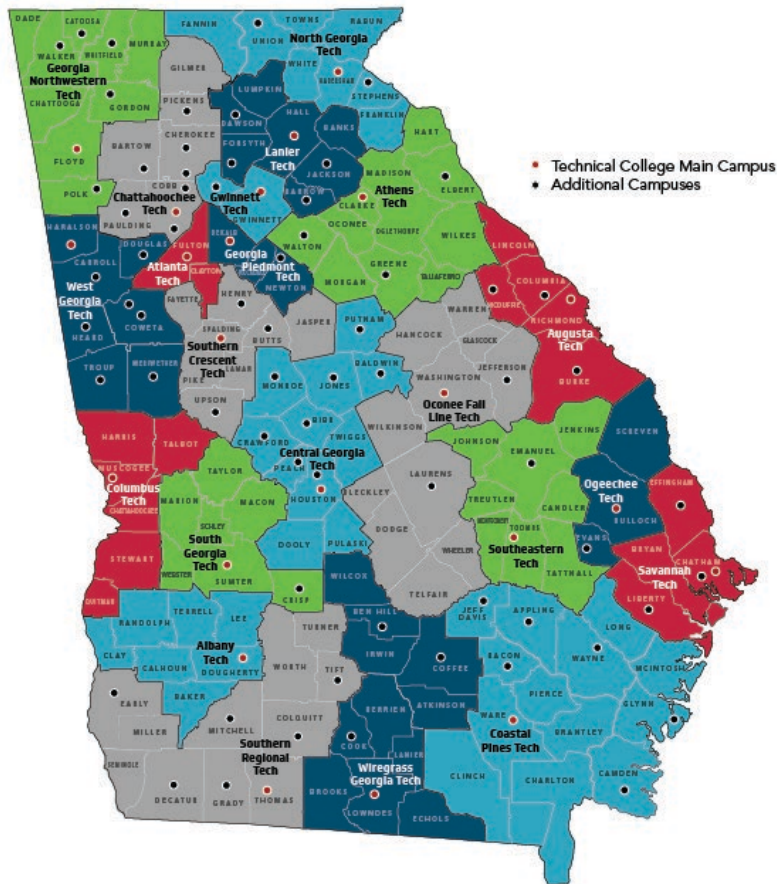

Job placement Rate in-field

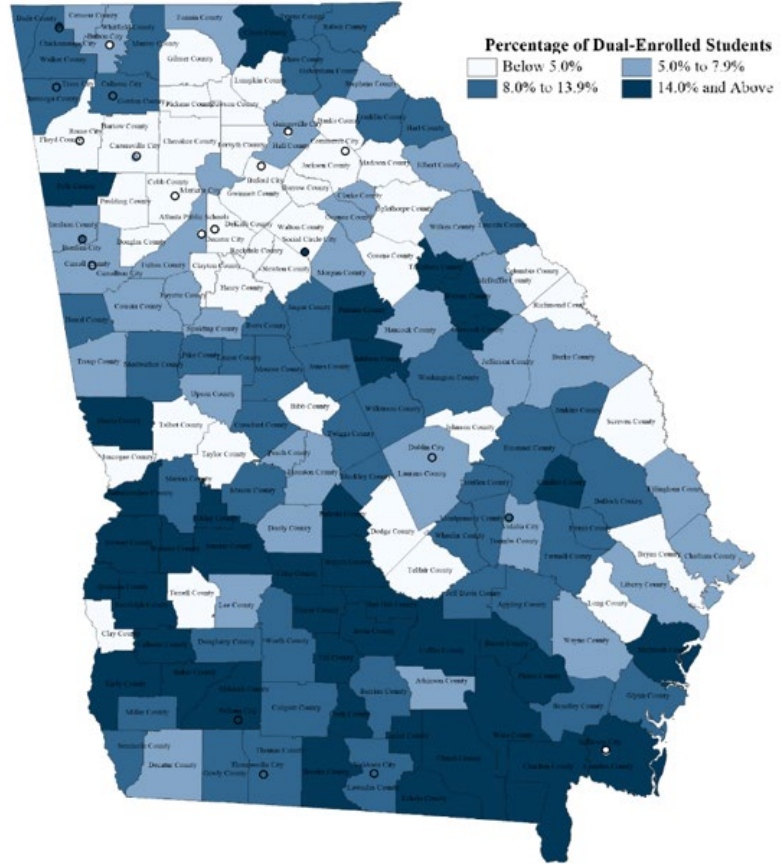
