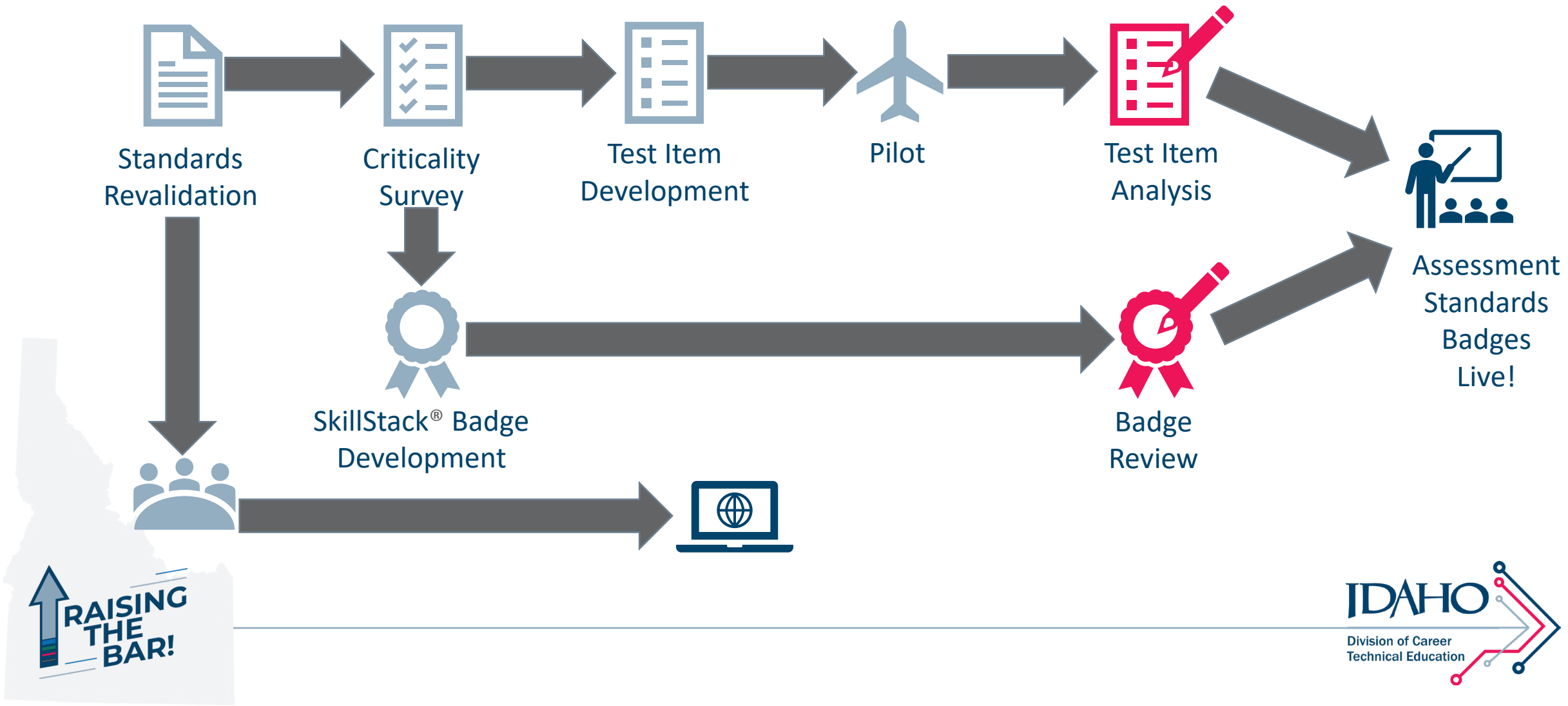

Juniors or seniors who complete a CTE pathway are eligible if they:



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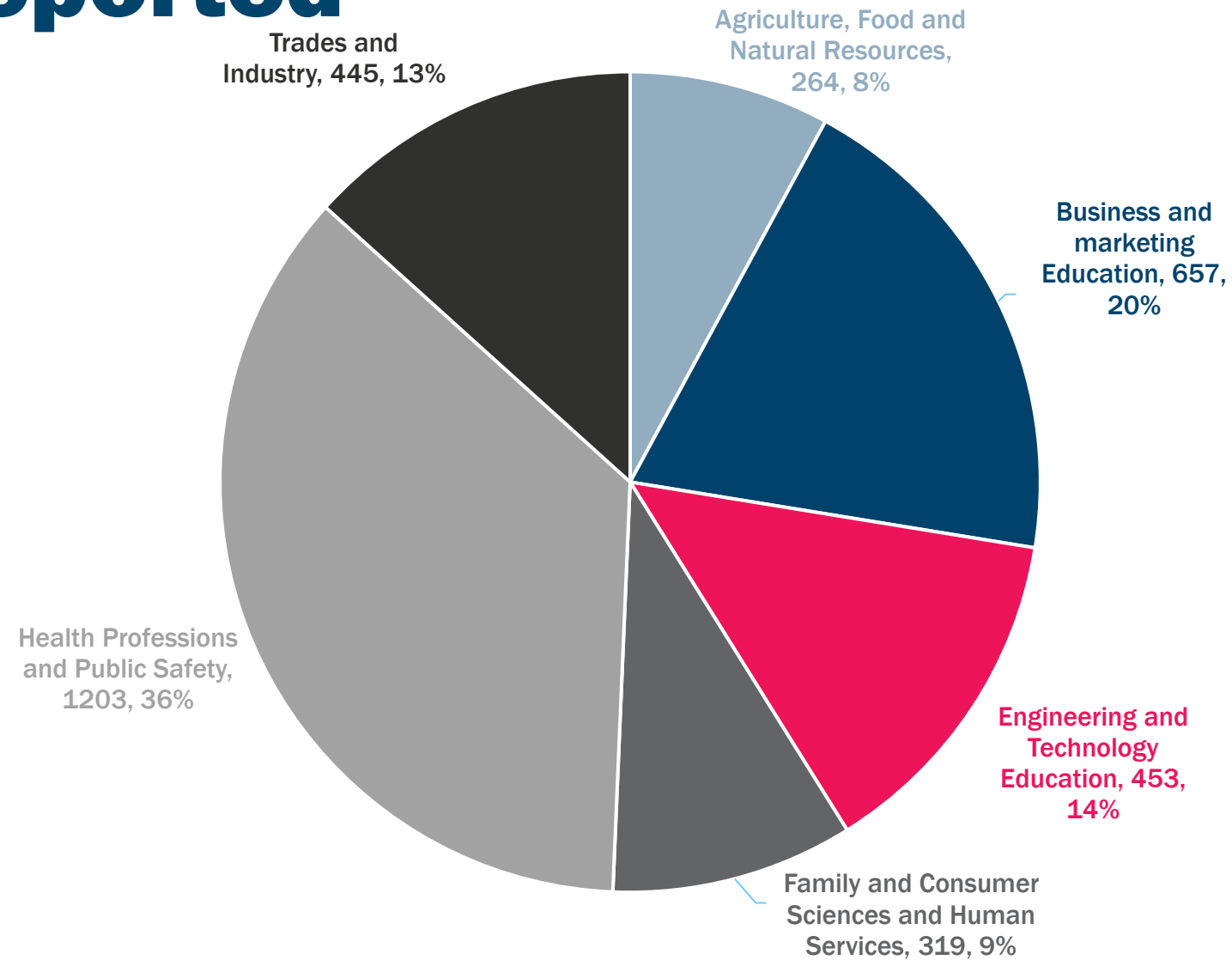
24/25: API from E-SESS to badges

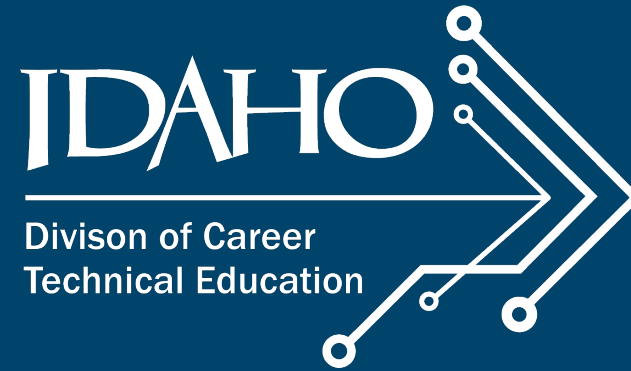
