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### Why Workplace Readiness Skills (WRS) in Virginia?

- In the Commonwealth, WRS are the first 22 REQUIRED competencies (learning objectives) of every middle and high school CTE course.
- These competencies have been embedded in each CTE course to meet the needs of Virginia's employers. (think soft skills)

### What are the Workplace Readiness Skills (WRS)?

The 22 WRS are organized around three core areas:

- 1. personal qualities and abilities, like creativity, work ethic, and problem solving;
- **1. interpersonal skills**, like conflict resolution, teamwork, and respect for diversity; and
- **1. professional competencies**, like information security, professionalism, and career and life management.

## The Workplace Readiness Skills for the Commonwealth Assessment

- Students demonstrate their knowledge of these competencies and their preparedness for employment — through the Workplace Readiness Skills for the Commonwealth Assessment.
- The assessment was created in coordination with the Virginia Department of Education Office of Career, Technical, and Adult Education.
- Students who pass the assessment earn the <u>CTECS WRS</u> <u>Assessment Digital Badge</u>.

## Why the Assessment in Chesterfield County Public Schools?

- School Division 65,000 (2023)
  - 11 high schools and 1 technical center (2 locations)
  - 29,000 CTE students (grades 6-12)
- 2018 data **1,718** WRS tests given (multiple student attempts)

## Why the Assessment in Chesterfield County Public Schools?

 Divisionwide shift through open discussions with our stakeholders.

 A collective decision was made to embrace and promote WRS in all of our <u>CTE Programs of Study (POS)</u> <u>in Chesterfield County</u> as we see the value in teaching/assessing such qualities and skills.

## Why the Assessment in Chesterfield County Public Schools?

 Our <u>POS</u> aligns the WRS test with the first level course in all of our technical center programs. This is in addition to other certifications of value.

 Our <u>POS</u> also aligns the WRS test with the second level course in all of our high school CTE course pathways.

#### **Assessment Outcomes**

- In SY22-23, **4,062 (tripled since 2018)** Chesterfield County students sat for the WRS test.
- 2,951 students passed for a 72.64% pass rate.
