

- \* Students are required to complete courses in Geography or World History to earn the Standard Diploma, Courses in Geography or World History can be taken to fulfill the requirement for Humanities or as an elective course. For students seeking the Advanced Diploma or the College and Career Ready (CCR) Diploma, courses in World History or Geography can be taken to fulfill requirements for Humanities, an elective course, or Social Studies.
- \*\* The sequence of courses to fulfill the Mathematic requirements for all three diploma types may include Pre Algebra, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II or higher.

College and Career Ready Flex Credit Prepares recipients of a Standard Diploma for workforce




