The regional math creates an impossible scheduling burden



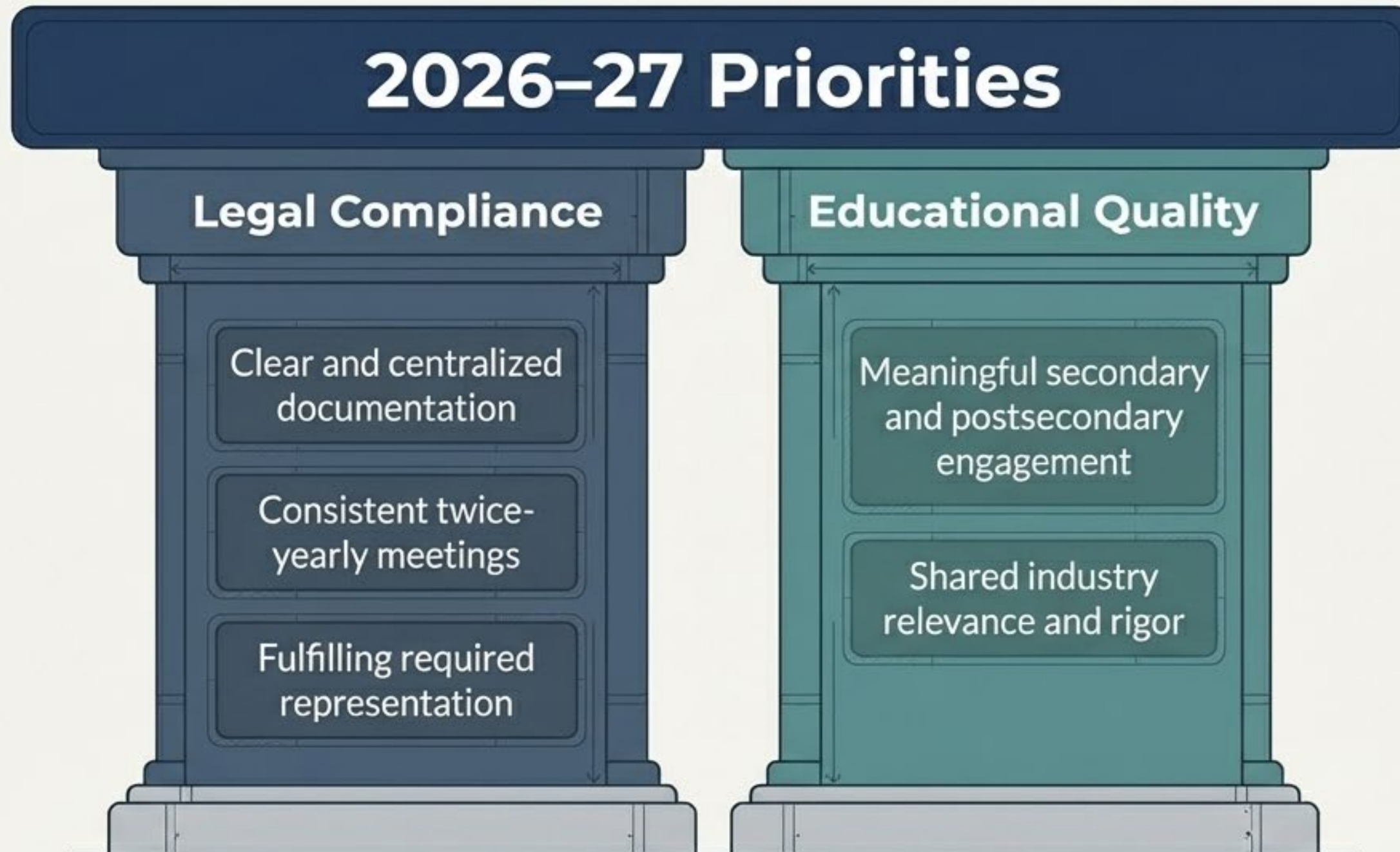
Each program is required to maintain an active advisory committee

Representation from both secondary and postsecondary partners is mandatory

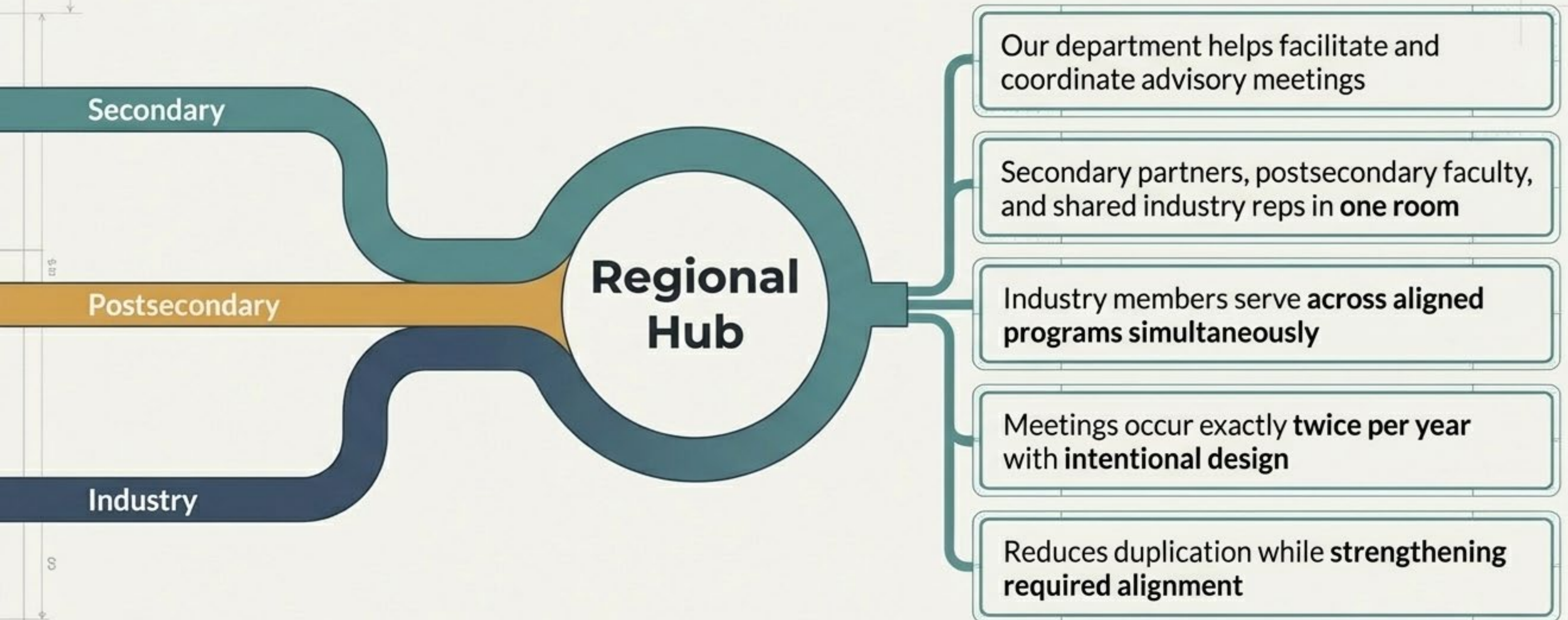
Committees must meet at least twice per year

Transitioning to a coordinated regional advisory model



How the regional model streamlines faculty and administrative workload

	Current State	Regional Model
Meeting Frequency	Up to 30+ fragmented meetings annually	Consolidated to exactly 2 regional meetings
Teacher Workload	High burnout and duplicated efforts	Protected time and reduced individual burden
Industry Voice	Diluted input and scheduling fatigue	Stronger, shared industry representation
Compliance Tracking	High risk of missing or scattered documentation	Guaranteed Perkins documentation and regional consistency
