

A student is deemed "career-ready" if the student meets one of the following criteria:

- Is a CTE completer and earns a national industry credential or a state industry credential as determined by the business community. [CCRSY20SY21]
- Earns a Silver, Gold or Platinum National Career Readiness Certificate on the ACT WorkKeys exam or earns a Level 3 Credential or above on the WIN Ready to Work Career Assessment.
- Earns a scale score of 31 or higher on the ASVAB.
- WorkKeys exam or Silver, Gold or Platinum Credential on the WIN Ready to Work Career Assessment.
- Earns a scale score of 31 or higher on the ASVAB.
- Successfully completes a state-approved work-based learning exit evaluation from an employer.
